CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION EMPLOYEE SENTENCED ON BRIBERY RELATED OFFENSE

United States Walker RALEIGH -Attorney Thomas G. announced today RHONDA BOYD, 28, a former correctional officer Correctional Institution, the Rivers Winton, at North Carolina, was sentenced today by United States District Judge Louise W. Flanagan to 20 months imprisonment, to be followed by 2 years of supervised release.

The investigation revealed that **BOYD**, while employed as a correctional officer at the Rivers Correctional Institution, conspired to commit bribery in violation of Title 18 United States Code, Sections 371. The evidence showed that for approximately 6 months in 2011 2012, accepted and BOYD payments from inmates within the facility in return for smuggling in contraband items such as cell phones and cigarettes.

Investigation of this case was conducted by the Department of Justice, Office of Inspector General and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, with assistance provided by the United States Postal Inspection Service.
